Board of Trustees Minutes of the October 8, 2024 Meeting

Members Present: Kay, Lyn, Dick, Dennis, Sandra, Carol, and Pastor Chuck

Call to Order, Kay Opening Prayer, Pastor Chuck

Reading of the Minutes of the September 17, 2024 meeting. Correct the amount paid to John Carbajal for the boulevard trees project to reflect \$1630.34. M-Dick 2nd-Sandra to approve minutes as corrected. Motion passed.

Kay presented the Financial Reports: The payment to John Carbajal was charged to Church Maintenance. It should have been from the Capital Improvement account. The correction will be shown on the October reports. Overall revenue is up for the year thus far, and expenses are under budget. M-Lyn 2nd-Dennis to approve the Financials as presented. Motion passed.

Kay presented an update on the Front Steps project. She received estimates from James Urbanski, dba Urban Garage Systems to resurface the landing and steps with a non-slip, Epoxy material. The consensus is to accept the estimate in the amount of \$1562.93 and get on James' schedule to complete before the end of the month. The color gray was chosen. The members also thanked Dick for grinding the old paint and rust from the metal framework of the front steps. He also painted the metal framework and metal railings with new black paint.

Discussion regarding the church sign on the front lawn was entertained to finalize the design, materials, and wording. The consensus is to install a metal, laser-cut sign, 6 feet wide by 4 feet high with a black metal frame, installed on a concrete base. The top of the sign will be arched similar to the bronze plaque above the front doors. The wording chosen is: First Congregational Church (top line), Come Worship With Us (2nd line), w.w.w.BFSOUCC.org (3rd line), and appropriate artwork. Austin Bishop and students will draft the design and fabricate the sign. Kevin Fuhrer has offered to prepare the base and install the sign.

Blake Hunter and a helper have replaced the valves to the boiler. The cost of the materials will be charged to the Capital Improvement account. M-Dick 2nd-Lyn to reimburse Blake \$551.97 for materials and authorize Kathy to issue a \$250.00 check to his helper for his time. Motion passed. Blake has also volunteered to refinish the wooden door on the East side of the church.


Kay reported that the two CDs are up for renewal: the \$50,000. CD on 10/23/24 at a rate of 5.20%, the \$60,000. CD on 10/30/24 at a rate of 5.25% both for 6-month renewal terms. The interest earned, approximately \$2500. will be deposited into the Capital Improvement account. M-Dick 2nd-Dennis to renew both CDs for 6-months. Motion passed.

Kay stated that she is working on the church budget for 2025. The budget hearing will be at the November 12th Trustees meeting; and the report will be presented to the Church Council at their next meeting.

Pastor Chuck reported nothing for reimbursement this month.

Next Trustees meeting is November 12, 2024 at 5:30pm. Meeting adjourned at 6:40pm with prayer.
