






We Are Collecting "God Moments"

Motion #2: To change the current number of Deacons necessary to fill the Board of Deacons to 6. Moved by Larry Praeger, seconded by Barb Embry. Motion carried.

Motion #3: To change the current number of members on the Christian Education Board and their term. Three members will be elected each year at the annual meeting from the membership of the church for a term of one year. There will not be a limitation on the number of consecutive terms served. Moved by Devin Stephens, seconded by Steve Kappes. Motion carried.

January 15, 2025

Moderator John King called the meeting to order at 5pm.

Last meetings minutes were approved as written.

<u>Pastor's report-</u> Pastor Chuck was on vacation in late December into the first week of January. He expressed thanks to the pastors that served in his absence.

<u>Diaconate report</u>- The deacons undecorated and stored all the Christmas decorations. There are three deacons completing their terms. This leaves 6 members for the committee. Harlene Hill gave a shut in report to the deacons.

<u>Trustees report</u>- A proposed budget for 2025 was presented to the Council. A motion was made by John King to recommend the proposed budget as written to the congregation. Pew cushions have been ordered and the accepted deposit was made. The new cushions should arrive in March or April. The steps will be resurfaced in the spring.

<u>Christian Ed report</u>- There are 2 new students, making a total of 8 children attending Sunday school. The children have completed their nativity sets. Upcoming events are the Easter Egg Hunt for Easter. On Mother's Day and Father's Day the children will be presenting a small skit/talk. There is going to be a cookie sale on the first Sunday in February after church.

<u>Old business</u>- The council went over items for the annual meeting.

<u>New business</u>- Reports for the annual meeting are being received. There is another light in the basement that Blake Hunter is changing out.

Board of Trustees Minutes of the January 5, 2025 Meeting at 5:30 pm

Present: Kay, Dick, Shawn, Sandra, Dennis, and Carol

Call to Order and Opening Prayer, Kay

The minutes of the December 12, 2024 meeting were read, and approved as presented.

Kay presented the December 31, 2024 Financial Reports: The year ended with \$12,000. income above 2023, expenses were \$5600. under budget resulting in a year-end net income of \$8997.68. The year- end balance of the Pioneer Bank account was \$47,525.21. The Special Funds accounts ended the year with healthy balances. Undesignated Memorial funds will be used to purchase new pew cushions at a total cost of \$5787.90. The cushions have been ordered and the deposit paid. There are two accounts with balances that could be transferred to the Capital Improvement Fund., \$15.00 from the Delta Dental account and \$9000. from the hail damage line item. Motion Dick 2nd Dennis to ask Kathy to move \$9000. from the hail damage account to the Capital Improvement Fund. Motion passed. Motion Shawn 2nd Dennis to move \$15. from the Delta Dental account to the Capital Improvement Fund. Motion passed.

Kay presented updates on several old business items: The brass plates to update the Memorial Gift Plaque will require the purchase of an additional plaque. The Memorial Gift Plaque will have to be moved, since the current space will not accommodate another plaque, a topic for future discussion. Reviewed the church sign design, color, and artwork, an item for future finalization. The resurfacing of the front steps is on hold until spring. The invoice for the resurfacing material has been paid. James Urbanic will complete the project when weather permits.

Kay introduced the new business items: The Fire Marshall has required the purchase and installation of a carbon monoxide detector in the boiler room. Mischelle has been informed that it is also necessary for the recertification of the Day Care. By consensus, Dennis will check into what is available and make the purchase. A suggestion was explored regarding the purchase of a battery-powered snow blower for the church. Dennis offered to investigate options before the next meeting.

Kay presented the Proposed 2025 Budget. The total proposal is \$110,042. for 2025, the 2024 total budget amount was \$93, 951. It was reviewed and there is ample opportunity for savings, since the actual 2024 expenses were under budget, and the actual income was above the amount budgeted. Motion Sandra 2nd Dennis to accept Kay's proposed church budget for 2025, and refer it to the Church Council for presentation to the congregation at the Annual Meeting. Motion passed.

The Board members thanked Kay for her faithful leadership and commitment to the Church.

The February meeting date and time TBD after the Annual Meeting.

Closing prayer by Kay. Meeting adjourned at 6:35 pm.

Shut in Report: Harlene made many calls those whom she calls are always appreciate having someone from the church check in on them.




New Business: Three members will be coming off the diaconate board and the 5 + one youth, remaining current members will fill the diaconate board for 2025.
